- This year will be the 85th annual celebration of the Our Lady of Guadalupe Novena
- Over 500 children were born at a clinic founded in the 1950s to help meet the needs of the migrants and surrounding communities
- St. Joseph Credit Union chartered in 1949 to help those that could not afford the high interest rates of local banks. Catholic Family Credit Union is the offspring of St. Joseph Credit Union.
- The first school opened in 1877 and the Dominican Sisters came in 1855 to take charge of the school. The Dominican Sisters were the first Religious sisters to come to Saginaw
- Msgr. Bolton, along with Fr. LaMarre, recognized the changing face of the community, embraced it, and our community flourished. Fr. LaMarre continued to come to St. Joseph's until the year he died. He loved the people and the people loved him
- The Capuchins came to St. Joseph Church in 1966 and continue to maintain a wonderful pastoral presence to this day.
- We have a substantial mortgage that we are paying.
